96% opposition to Rosia Montana gold mine proposal

A consultation process conducted by the Romanian Parliament has been inviting people to comment on the Rosia Montana mine proposal since last October. As of 22 January, 96% of a total of 6617 participants voted against Gabriel Resource's open cyanide leach gold mining proposal.
